

## **GRANT COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT SCHOLARSHIP**

The Grant County Conservation District will sponsor a scholarship in the amount of \$500.00.

This scholarship will be awarded to a student enrolled in Grant County Schools.

Each year students have the opportunity to submit applications to the directors of the Grant County Conservation District.

### **Criteria for student receiving scholarship is as follows:**

1. Must be a senior in high school, planning to attend a college or university in Arkansas and majoring in an Agricultural or Soil & Water Conservation related field.
2. Must have recommendations of his/her superintendent or principal and his/her vocational agriculture instructor. **(The principal/teacher recommendation needs to be comprehensive, as substantial consideration is given to this recommendation). Please attach letter from principal and Vo-Ag instructor to application.**
3. Student must exhibit traits of leadership, citizenship, dependability, and need for the scholarship. Please note these traits on your application form.
4. A check in the amount of \$500 will be mailed to you upon proof of enrollment.

When applications are received, the Grant County Conservation District Board of Directors will determine the awardee on the basis of recommendations given by his/her teachers, neatness of application and student grades. The district board will make the selection at the board meeting in March 2016.

### **Instructions for completing application:**

1. **Must be typewritten or neatly printed.**
2. **Must have all pertinent information filled out.**
3. **Must be returned to the Grant County Conservation District Office by 2:00 p.m. on March 24, 2016.**
4. **Must have school transcript attached.**
